MEMBERS OF ONE ANOTHER

Therefore having put aside the lie, let each speak truth with his neighbor! for we are **members** of one another.

Ephesians 4:25

MEMBERS OF THE BODY OF CHRIST

For just as in one body we have many **members**, but all the **members** do not have the same action; thus we the many are one body in Christ, and each one **members** of one another.

Romans 12:4,5

Do you not know that your bodies are **members** of Christ? Having taken then the members of the Christ, shall I make *them* **members** of a harlot? May it not be.

1 Corinthians 6:15

For just as the body is one, and has many **members**, but all the **members** of the one body, being many, are one body; so also the Christ. For also in one spirit we all in one body were immersed, whether Jews, whether Greeks, whether slaves, whether free; and all into one spirit given to drink. For also the body is not one **member**, but many. If the foot should say that, I am not a hand, I am not of the body; *it is* not because of this it is not of the body. And if the ear should say that, I am not an eye, I am not of the body; *it is* not because of this it is not of the body. If all the body *was* an eye, where *would be* the hearing? If all *was* hearing, where *would be* the smelling? But now God made the **members**, each one of them in the body, as he wanted. But if it was all *were* one **member**, where the body? But now there are many **members** indeed, but one body. And *the* eye is not able to say to the hand, I have no need of you; or again the head to the feet, I have no need of you. But more rather, the members of the body which see to be weaker are important; and the ones which seem to be exceedingly without honor of the body, these we invest more extra honor; and our indecent *parts* have more extra decency; but our decent parts have no need. But God mixed together the body to the *part* lacking, having given more extra honor, that there might not be a split in the body, but that the **members** should have the same concern for one another. And whether one **member** suffers, all the **members** suffer along; whether one **member** be glorified, all the **members** rejoice along. But you are *the* body of Christ, and **members** in turn. And whom indeed God appointed in the assembly, first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, thereupon *works* of power, then favors of cures, assistance, guidance, types of languages. Not all *are* apostles. Not all *are* prophets. Not all *are* teachers. Not all *are* works of power. Not all have favors of cures. Not all speak languages. Not all interpret. But be zealous for the better favors.
