SPECIFICS OF VOWS

And if it should be a vow, he should sacrifice the voluntary offering, the one of his gift offering; in which ever day he should bring his sacrifice it shall be eaten and in the next morning.

Lev 7:16

And a man who ever should offer a sacrifice of deliverance to the LORD, while setting apart a vow, or according to a choice offering, or in your holiday feasts, out of the herds or of the sheep, it shall be unblemished for acceptance....but for your vow it shall not be taken.

Lev 22:21,23

And if you should sacrifice a sacrifice vow of joyfulness to the LORD, you shall sacrifice it acceptable to you; in that day it shall be eaten; you shall not leave of the meats into the morning.

Lev 22:29,30

And you shall offer yield offerings to the LORD, or a whole burnt-offering, or sacrifice offering to magnify a vow...

Nm 15:3,8

These things you shall do to the LORD in your holidays, besides your vows...

Nm 29:39

And you shall bring there the whole burnt-offerings of yours, and your sacrifices, and your tenths, and your vow offerings, and your voluntary offerings, and your acknowledgment offerings, the first-born of your oxen, and of your sheep.

Dt 12:6

You shall not be able to eat in your cities the tithe of your grain, and of your wine, of your olive oil, the first-born of your oxen, and of your sheep, and all the vows, as many as you should have vowed, and your acknowledgment offerings, and the first-fruits of your hands - but only before the LORD your God shall you eat them in the place in which ever the LORD your God himself should choose for you and your son and daughter, your manservant and your maidservant, and the Levite, and the foreigner in your cities.

Dt 12:17

Except your holy things, which ever should come to you, and taking your vow offerings, you shall come into the place which ever the LORD your God should choose his name to be called upon there.

Dt 12:26

You shall not bring the hire of a harlot, nor the price of a dog, into the house of the LORD your God for any vow.

Dt 23:18

And if you shall vow a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not pass time to give it; for requiring, the LORD your God shall require it from you; and it will be sin to you. But if you should not want to make a vow, it is not a sin to you. The things going forth through your lips you shall guard, and you shall do in which manner you made a vow to the LORD your god in the matter of a gift which your mouth spoke.

Dt 23:21

And one vowing to the LORD, and it will be accepted for him; and he shall enter with a clean face, with an utterance of praise; and he will recompense righteousness to men.

Job 33:26

It is a snare to a man quickly to sanctify anything of his own; for after vowing it, changing of the mind happens.

Pr 30:25

As when you vow a vow to God, you should not pass time to render it, for his will is not in foolish vows. You then, as much as you should have vowed, render! Better for you to not make a vow than for you to make a vow and not repay.

And the people cried out to Moses. And Moses made a vow to the LORD, and the fire abated.

VOW RENDERED IN JERUSALEM

A hymn is becoming to you, O god, in Zion; and to you the vow shall be rendered in Jerusalem.

VOW RENDERED IN THE TEMPLE

I will enter into your house with whole burnt-offerings. I will render to you my vows, which my lips drew apart, and my mouth spoke in my affliction.

Ps 66:13,14

VOW RENDERED IN PUBLIC

My vows to the LORD I will render before all his people.

Ps 116:114,118

THE LAW OF THE VOW OF A LIFE

Speak to the sons of Israel! And you shall say unto them, A man who ever should vow a vow for a value of his life to the LORD, it will be the value of a male from twenty years unto sixty years old - his value will be fifty double-drachmas of silver by the holy weight. And the female will be the price of thirty double-drachmas

Lev 27:2-end

A man - a man who ever should vow a vow to the LORD, or should swear by an oath, or should confirm a set of limits upon his life, he shall not profane his word; all as many things as should come forth from out of his mouth he shall do.

Nm 30:2,3,9

THE LAW OF THE VOW OF PURITY

A man or woman, who ever should greatly vow a vow to purify oneself in purity to the LORD, from wine and liquor he shall be pure, and strong drink from out of

wine...All the days of his vow, from all as many things as come from the grapevine, wine, from dregs unto grape-stone, he shall not eat. All the days of the vow of his purification a razor shall not come upon his head until whenever the days should be fulfilled, as many as he made a vow to the LORD. He shall be holy, maintaining the lock of hair on his head. All the days of the vow to the LORD he shall not enter unto any soul coming to an end...for his vow of God is upon him, upon his head. All the days of his vow will be holy to the LORD. And if anyone should die to death near him suddenly the head of his vow shall be defiled; and he shall shave his head in which day he should be cleansed; the seventh day he shall be shaved...And this is the law of the making a vow; in which ever day he shall have fulfilled the days of his vow, he shall bring himself by the doors of the tent of the testimony, and he shall lead his gift to the LORD - one unblemished he-lamb of a year old for a whole burnt-offering...And the one making a vow shall shave by the doors of the tent of the testimony the head of his vow; and he shall place the hair upon the fire, the one which is upon the sacrifice of the deliverance offering. And the priest shall take the shoulder cooked from the ram, and one unleavened bread from the bin, and one unleavened pancake; and he shall place them upon the hands of the one making a vow, after his shaving of his head. And the priest shall offer them as an increase offering before the LORD; it shall be a holy portion to the priest beside the breast of the increase offering, and beside the shoulder of the cut-away portion offering. And after this the one making a vow shall drink wine. This is the law of the one making a vow; who ever should make a vow to the LORD of his gift to the LORD, concerning the vow, separate from what ever his hand should find according to ability of his vow, of what ever he should have vowed according to the law of his purity.

Nm 6:2-22

THE VOW OF BELIEF

Is anyone sick among you? Let him call on the elders of the assembly, and let them pray over him, having anointed him with olive oil in the name of the LORD! And the vow of belief will deliver the weary one, and the LORD will raise him.

James 5:14,15

JACOB VOWS

And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If the LORD God should be with me, and should guard me in this journey which I go, and should give to me bread to eat, and a cloak to put on, and will return me with safety unto the house of my father, and the LORD will be to me for God, and this stone which I set as a monument, will be to me a

house of God. And all, whatever you should give to me, I will tithe a tenth of it to you.

Gen 28:20

I am God, the one appearing to you in the place of God, of which you anointed to me there a monument, and vowed to me there a vow.

Gen 31:13

THE VOWS OF MOSES

And Pharaoh called Moses and Aaron, and said, Make a vow for me to the LORD, and remove the frogs from me, and from my people! And I will send the people, and they shall sacrifice to the LORD. And Moses said to Pharaoh, Order for me! when should I make a vow for you ...

Ex 8:8,9

Make a vow then for me to the LORD! And Moses said, Behold I will go forth from you, and I will make a vow to God...And Moses went forth from Pharaoh, and made a vow to God. And the LORD did just as Moses said...

Ex 8:28-30

Make a vow then to the LORD...

Ex 9:28

And Moses went forth from Pharaoh and made a vow to God.

Ex 10:18

And the people came to Moses, saying that, We sinned, for we spoke ill against the LORD, and against you; make a vow then to the LORD that he remove from us the serpent And Moses made a vow for the people.

JEPHTHAH'S FOOLISH VOW

And Jephthah vowed a vow to the LORD... And it came to pass after the end of the two months that she returned to her father, and Jephthah completed his vow which he vowed. And she did not know a man.

HANNAH'S VOW

And she vowed a vow, saying, O LORD of hosts, if looking you should look upon the humiliation of your maidservant, and should give to your maidservant seed of a male, then I will put him before you, dedicated until the day of his death.

1Sa 1:11

The LORD makes poor, and he enriches...giving the thing vowed for to the one vowing.

1Sa 2:9

ELKANAH'S VOW

And the man Elkanah ascended, and all his house, to sacrifice in Shiloh, for the sacrific of the days, and his vows.

1Sa 1:21

ABSALOM'S LYING VOW

And it came to pass at the end of forty years, that Absalom said to his father, I will go indeed and pay my vows which I vowed to the LORD in Hebron. For your servant vowed a vow in my living in Geshur in Shria, saying, If in returning the LORD shall return me to Jerusalem, then I will serve to the LORD....

And there was not one unjust thing in my hands, and my vow is pure.

PAUL'S VOWS
